BASIC EXPECTATIONS

Mount Hotham Free Ski is proud to offer scholarships to select athletes that show a strong determination and are outstanding in their chosen sporting discipline. The athlete is also able to present themselves in a kind and respectful manner to all, and enhance the team and club environment. Athletes will be an ambassador for the club, and there in will have an expectation to present themselves according to the core values of the club.

MHFS athletes shall conduct themselves in a manner that exemplifies good behaviour and is consistent with the MHFS core values

- Commitment, Teamwork, Integrity and Humility.
Any breach of the Code of Conduct will result in termination of a scholarship award.

Specific rules of conduct include, but are not limited to the following;

1. Athletes representing Mount Hotham Free Ski and their community shall conduct themselves with honesty, integrity and respect for coaches and others at all times, including during all non MHFS activities.
2. Athletes will contribute to a safe and positive learning environment for all.
3. Athletes will treat with respect all club property, the property of other athletes, all on mountain facilities and the property of all hotels and accommodations.
4. All athletes will obey regulations of the Mount Hotham Skiing Company (MHSC) and shall conduct themselves in a responsible manner when on MHSC mountains and property.
5. Athletes will maintain a neat and clean appearance during all training, travel and competition times.
6. Athletes in away training camps and competitions including all award ceremonies and promotional activities will dress in full uniform at all times.
7. The head coach will assist, construct and determine appropriate training programs and competition involvement for athletes.
8. Scholarship holder performance presentation expectation levels will be reviewed monthly.
9. Athletes will show a continued commitment to their sport and display a year round involvement within beneficial training systems.
10. Athletes will be available to present for select MHFS activities and promotional events.
11. Athletes shall abstain from the use of marijuana or illegal drugs, consumption of alcohol and any form of tobacco at all times, including during all non MHFS activities.
12. Athletes shall abstain from the use of profane and abusive language.
13. Athletes will refrain from any form of inappropriate sexual contact.
14. The head coaches' decision will be final in all matters of the Code of Conduct.

I understand that if I am in breach of this agreement set out in the Code of Conduct, then MHFS has the right to terminate any scholarship award. At such time the recipient will be obligated to repay MHFS the total amount of the scholarship award.
